Willsboro-Essex Summer Camp Program at Noblewood EpiPen Policy and Authorization for Administration

EpiPen Policy

Campers with severe or life threatening allergies that require an EpiPen must supply TWO up to date EpiPens upon arrival at Noblewood Lodge.

One EpiPen must stay with the camper or counselor (depending if camper is authorized to self-carry), for the duration of the camp.

The second EpiPen must stay with the Day Camp Director for the duration of camp.

Both EpiPens must be unexpired.

Campers self-carrying:

EpiPen must be prescribed by a camper’s physician with written authorization and instructions that the camper may “self-carry”.

EpiPen must stay in the camper’s backpack or on their person in close proximity to them at all times.

A camper who is self-carrying their EpiPen is encouraged to self-administer their EpiPen if needed. *Alternatively, a member of the camp staff can administer the EpiPen if the camper is unable to do so.*

Camp Staff carrying a camper’s EpiPen:

EpiPen must be prescribed by camper’s physician with written authorization and instruction for administration.

Written authorization by the camper’s parent/guardian directing a staff member to carry the camper’s EpiPen must be provided upon camper check-in.
